



Chemical Awareness Class FAQ

What is it?

This class is an alcohol and substance use prevention class. During the class, we will cover topics such as why teens use chemicals, how various chemicals affect the teenage brain, the specific dangers various chemicals present, addiction, goal setting, and values. In addition, each youth will identify what factors in their life put them at risk for using substances and what factors could help them stay away from chemicals naturally.

Where is the class held?

The class is held at Lakes Center for Youth and Families: 20 Lake St. N, Suite 103, Forest Lake

How long is the class?

The Chemical Awareness Class is a three hour long class. The class is typically held once a month.

How much does the class cost?

The Chemical Awareness Class costs \$100. Fees can be paid with a cash, card, or check.
